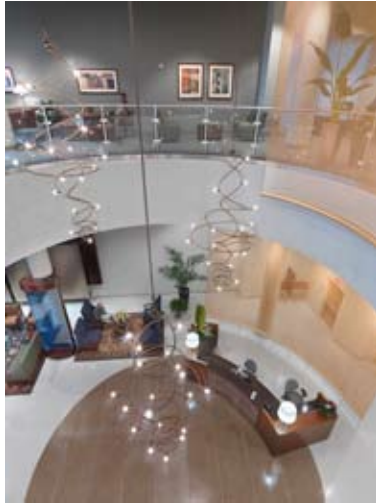


St. John Hospital and Medical Center:

New main entrance

The first phase of Van Elslander Pavilion, a \$163 million project, was completed in September 2007. The three-story atrium lobby serves as the new main entrance for the hospital, and transports patients and visitors into an open, airy lobby that is separate from its daily activity, yet directly linked to it for convenience and efficiency.



Private patient rooms

SJH&MC has recently opened several new floors, each with all private patient rooms. Each of the 144 private patient rooms include beautiful furniture and fixtures, private bathrooms and sofas, and a flat-screen television. Sound absorbing materials that help maintain a quiet and peaceful environment. The floors have welcoming family waiting rooms, physicians team conference rooms, architecture to support SJH&MC's migration to computerized charting, and custom nurse work spaces that keep the caregivers close to the patients.



Consolidated outpatient services

Hundreds of outpatients come to SJH&MC each day for diagnostic imaging or lab tests. These services have been consolidated and relocated next to the atrium lobby. The new location is more patient-friendly and accessible. Free ground-level parking is conveniently located immediately outside the main Van Elslander Pavilion entrance.

Beautiful dining for patients and visitors

Patients needing inpatient care have can access our “At your Request” room service, which offers patients a variety of salad, pasta, pizza, and entrees. For visitors, SJH&MC has the beautiful, airy Moross Market Café, which serves a variety of hot and cold food, and Brioche Doree, which offers French pastries, breakfast sandwiches, and specialty sandwiches, salads, and soups.



Excellence in cardiac care

In keeping with the hospital’s role as a national leader in heart care, the W. Warren Shelden Heart and Circulatory Center has been specially designed to offer an environment where specialists in cardiology, cardiovascular and vascular surgery, neurosurgery and radiology can collaborate to provide a cross-functional approach to patient care. The Center of Excellence houses five cath labs, two EP labs, and two interventional radiology labs, along with private pre-procedural recovery rooms.



All private treatment rooms in Emergency Center

When renovations are complete in January 2009, the Emergency Center will offer patients privacy with more than 70 all private treatment rooms. The Emergency Center also has a dedicated 64-slice CT scanner, helping staff to process imaging studies more quickly. Finally, the Emergency Center offers waiting areas that offer patients additional privacy and comfort.



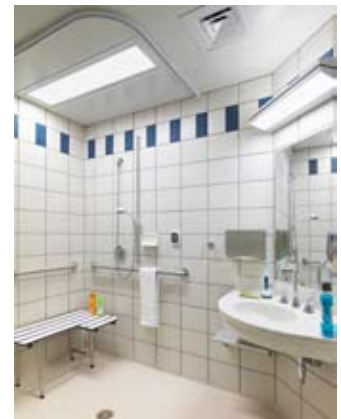
Spa-like recovery in orthopedics and neurosurgery

For spinal surgical patients and neurosurgery patients, patients have private rooms, with a planned Rehabilitation Services Satellite area for group and individual exercise, gait training, stair training, and patient education. Patients are part of the Body Spa program, and receive a special outfit to wear during their stay, instead of a hospital gown. These patients can choose to receive free massages, manicures and hair styling, and also receive a gourmet meal for themselves and a guest during their recuperation.
