

■ REGISTRATION

■ CANCELLATION POLICY

COURSE OVERVIEW

The Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) Provider Training courses is a performance oriented program designed to enable medical, nursing, allied health and paramedic personnel to apply current American Heart Association (AHA) standards to the delivery of emergency cardiac care.

The course is approved through the American Heart Association. **All courses start promptly at 8 a.m., with registration beginning at 7:30 a.m. outside the Peter Whyte Auditorium in the Lower Level of St. John Hospital and Medical Center.**

PROVIDER COURSE

The course reviews the theories and skills required for successful adult resuscitation through lecture, demonstration and discussion. Small group participation, utilizing case based scenarios, facilitates the learning process. **The participant must come prepared with an understanding of Cardiac Rhythm Interpretation and the ACLS algorithms.**

REQUIREMENTS

The American Heart Association requires that ACLS course participants possess a current Basic Life Support (BLS) Healthcare Provider card. BLS training **WILL NOT BE OFFERED DURING THE ACLS COURSE.**
