



PROVIDENCE HOSPITAL DRIVER REHABILITATION

- **Providence Hospital Driver's Rehabilitation Program has been in existence since 1985 and state certified**
- **The program is designed to evaluate drivers who have a disability or illness that may limit their ability to drive. Such diagnosed may include CVA, Multiple Sclerosis, Cerebral Palsy, Rheumatoid Arthritis, Learning Disabilities, Amputee, Closed Head Injury (CHI), Low Vision, and a variety of others**
- **We provide a thorough evaluation that consists of a clinical assessment of physical, perceptual and visual skills, possible need for adaptive equipment and behind-the-wheel driving skills. The evaluation is designed to meet the individual needs of each client**
- **A licensed Occupational Therapist completes the pre-screening. A licensed Driver's Educator through A&A Driving School completes the course and residential driving portion of the assessment.**
- **All clients must have a valid driver license**
- **Our program is essentially a self-pay program, however it is sometimes covered by Michigan Vocational Services, Worker's Compensation and some private insurances as well as auto claims**
- **The program does not guarantee obtainment of a license from the State of MI. Only the Michigan Bureau of Motor Vehicles issues and rescinds driver's licenses according to their standards. Upon completion of our program, a report will be forwarded to the referring physician with recommendations regarding the client's driving skills**



- **Cost: Prescreening \$162.00; A&A Driving School approximately \$140.00 per hour**
- **Regular training sessions are available as needed at A&A Driving School**
