What's on the 1st Floor:

- New main entrance to St. John Hospital and Medical Center
- Campaign Donor Wall and Cumulative Giving Donor Wall
- Registration
- Outpatient Laboratory
- Non-Invasive Cardiology
- Fontbonne Diagnostic Imaging (Radiology) Department
- Rehabilitation Services

Great features for patients arriving at the new main entrance:

- Covered canopy and valet service beginning at 5 a.m. for a nominal fee. All self-parking is free.
- Reception desk staffed beginning at 5 a.m., providing assistance and way finding.
- Two-story atrium providing an airy and bright atmosphere.
- Registration area containing six private registration desks to respect individual privacy and confidentiality.

Great features for the Laboratory:

- Six private outpatient bloods draw areas.
- Pediatric treatment rooms feature a “zoo” theme to provide a fun atmosphere.
- Padded reclining chairs and televisions for patients needing long or complex testing.
- Convenient hours of operation: Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Great features for Non-Invasive Cardiology:

- Non-Invasive Cardiology testing is conveniently located on the main floor next to Diagnostic Imaging Services. Hours of operation for outpatient testing are 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- All testing performed by registered cardiac sonographers, cardiac nurses and exercise physiologists. The non-invasive laboratory is ICAEL (Intersocietal Commission for Accreditation of Echocardiography Laboratories), accredited in Echocardiography, Stress and Dobutamine Echocardiography and Transesophageal Echocardiography.
- The laboratory recently invested \$500,000 in state-of-the-art equipment in order to provide the highest quality diagnostic testing. In addition to echocardiography, other non-invasive cardiac testing performed in this private ten-room diagnostic area include stress testing, nuclear stress testing, EKGs, Holter monitors and event monitors.

Great features for Diagnostic Imaging:

- Outpatient hours of operation: Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; and Saturdays from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Area houses eight digital radiology suites, five nuclear imaging cameras, and three CT scanners (two of which are 64-slice with cardiac software).
- New cutting edge imaging technology includes two SPECT/CT cameras that have the ability to combine nuclear imaging and CAT scan imaging to make a more definitive diagnosis; new X-ray equipment to do image pasting (a digital solution to viewing long anatomical regions in a single image); dual energy subtraction that will allow for the removal of bony structures in the chest area for easier viewing of lungs and other soft tissue structures.

Great features for Rehabilitation Services:

- Offers physical, occupational, speech, pediatric rehab, massage therapy. Recently expanded to include evening hours: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.; Wednesday and Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Extensive team of clinical specialists, including a certified strength and conditioning specialist, orthopedic manual physical therapist, certified oncology rehabilitation therapists, and specially trained pediatric therapists.
