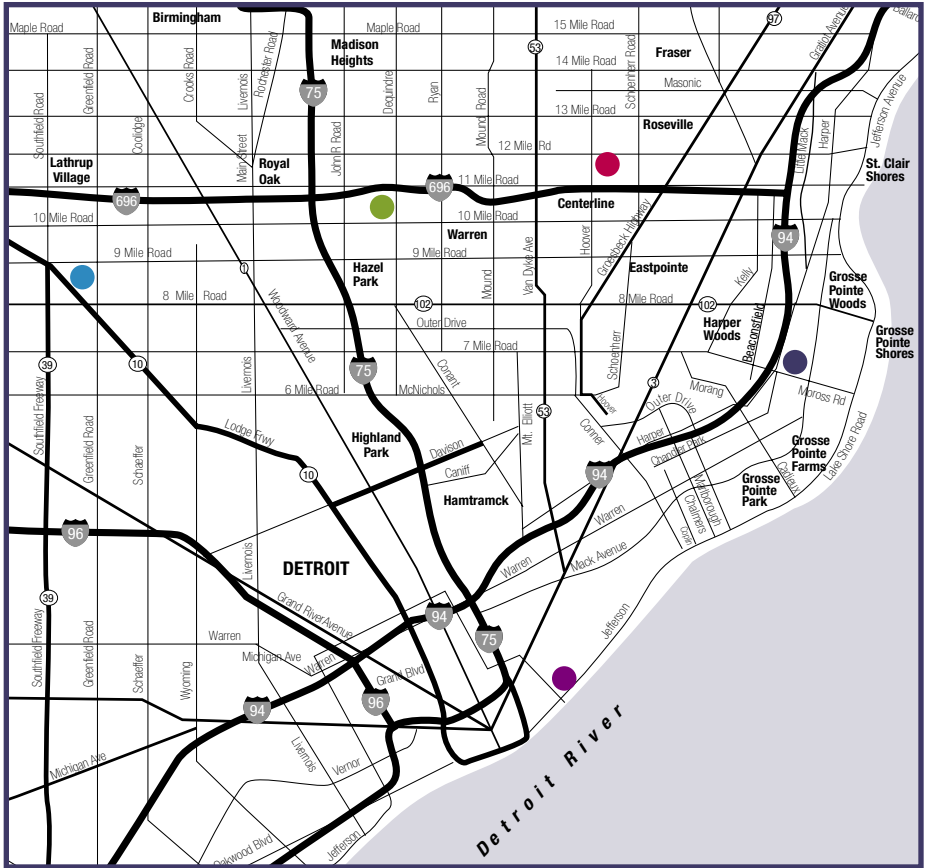
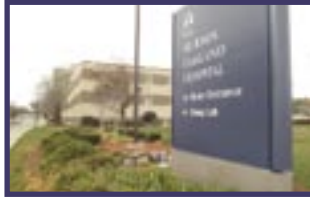

St John Hospital and Medical Center

A regional-referral teaching hospital with 607 licensed beds, a 700-member medical staff and more than 50 medical and surgical specialties. The east side's largest acute care provider and only designated Emergency Trauma Center. *Located on Moross Rd. on Detroit's east side, bordering Grosse Pointe.*

St. John Oakland Hospital

A 261-bed acute care, osteopathic teaching hospital, affiliated with Michigan State University and Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine. Provides a broad variety of inpatient/outpatient treatment, with specialties including cardiology, oncology, gerontology and complete mental health services. *Located at 11 Mile and Dequindre in Madison Heights.*

St. John Macomb Hospital

A 376-bed technologically advanced community hospital with inpatient/outpatient services including medical/surgical care, obstetrics/gynecology, cardiology, mental health services, oncology, intensive care, general and outpatient surgery, emergency medicine, physical medicine and rehabilitation. *Located on E. 12 Mile Road in Warren.*

St. John Detroit Riverview Hospital

This 285-bed hospital has been providing quality care to generations of families. It offers comprehensive inpatient/outpatient services, including medical/surgical care, obstetrics, gynecology, mental health service, general surgery, emergency medicine, the Comprehensive Rehabilitation Center and a teaching program in osteopathic medicine, affiliated with both Michigan State University and Kirksville College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Providence Hospital

A 459-bed hospital in Southfield provides medical, surgical, emergency and critical care, including dedicated rehabilitation and inpatient psychiatric units. Service lines include Oncology, Women's Health and Cardiology and other notable programs. The Providence network also includes more than 20 outpatient satellite centers in Novi, Farmington Hills, Livonia, South Lyon and Milford. (Affiliated with MichiganState University.)

Fellowship Training Program in Gastroenterology

Introduction

The subspecialty program will be jointly sponsored by St. John Detroit Riverview Hospital an acute care 262-bed community hospital and Providence Hospital. Providence Hospital is a 459-bed community teaching hospital that offers 14 residency-training programs and three fellowship programs. The sponsoring hospitals have full services in medicine, urology, surgery, pediatrics, pathology, radiology, emergency medicine, anesthesia, obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedics and multiple subspecialties in medicine and surgery.

Education Program

The Gastrology Fellowship is a three-year program. Residents in osteopathic internal medicine programs will have the opportunity of rotating on the gastroenterology service at Providence Hospital during the second and third year of the internal medicine residency. This will afford the resident the opportunity to more effectively compete for the fellowship positions.

At the conclusion of the training period, the resident will have mastered all the necessary skills for the clinical practice of gastrology.

Introduction

The two-year subspecialty residency training program in Nephrology is designed to develop clinical and laboratory skills and expertise in the diagnosis and management of acute and chronic renal disease, fluid and electrolyte disturbances, and the treatment of hypertension.

Education Program

The subspecialty program will be jointly sponsored by St. John Detroit Riverview Hospital an acute care 262-bed community hospital and Botsford General Hospital an acute care 330-bed community hospital which are approved by the American Osteopathic Association for intern and residency training, as well as multiple subspecialty training programs. The sponsoring hospitals have full services in medicine, urology, surgery, pediatrics, pathology, radiology, emergency medicine, anesthesia, obstetrics and gynecology, orthopedics and multiple subspecialties in medicine and surgery.

The Nephrology training sites include acute care within both hospitals and chronic dialysis services at the Botsford Kidney Center and nephrology and hemodialysis services at seven sites in the Detroit Metro area. Access to a renal transplantation program will provide experiences in pre and post transplant patient care. Electives will also be available to the residents.

At the conclusion of the training period, the resident will have mastered all the necessary skills for the clinical practice of nephrology.

Fellowship Training Program in Hematology/Oncology (Pending, anticipated start July 2006)

Introduction

This Fellowship in the hematology/oncology is designed to train physicians that will have the ability and qualifications to become a highly skilled consultant and caregiver treating his/her patients with the best outcome in the most cost efficient manner.

Education Program

The subspecialty program in combined Hematology and Oncology will provide clinical training and supervised experience in diagnosis and management of patients with hematologic disorders of nonmalignant and malignant nature, as well as malignant solid tumor disease. The subspecialty resident shall complete the training with competency in these combined specialties during a three-year program after completion of residency in general internal medicine.

The program will be under the direction of a board certified osteopathic physician in the subspecialty of hematology/oncology certified by the American Osteopathic Board of Internal Medicine. Osteopathic principles will be incorporated into the curriculum at all levels.

The entire first year will be spent at Providence Hospital in Southfield, Michigan. The rotation will consist of consultations in medical oncology, malignant hematology, as well as an opportunity to plan and implement a plan. One month will be spent on electives with Radiation Oncology at Providence Hospital, staffed and guided by the University of Michigan faculty. The other six months will be spent on the dedicated Inpatient Hematology-Oncology Teaching Service. This base training hospital offers an adequate scope, volume and variety of patients with hematologic and neoplastic diseases as well as a full scope of services including full laboratory and pathology services, including amino pathology, nuclear and medical imaging services, blood banking, transfusion, apheresis, coagulation laboratories and radiation oncology and full surgical services.
