EVERYDAY Rx

Your pharmacist can fill your prescription, but it's up to you to take your medication correctly. When taken improperly, medication can be less effective and sometimes even harmful. Ask your pharmacist if you have questions.

KNOW YOUR MEDICATION – Understand what medications you are taking. Know what the medication does, the correct dose, and when and how to take it.

TELL YOUR PHARMACIST – Tell your pharmacist what medications you are taking, any allergies or bad reactions you may have had to past medication, and if you have a condition that could interfere with your medication.

KEEP RECORDS – Keep records of your medications, and update those records when you get a new prescription.

ASK QUESTIONS – Ask about any side effects you experience. While some reactions are common, some can alert your pharmacist that you need a different type of medication or a different dosage.

FOLLOW DIRECTIONS – Read labels and ask your pharmacist about special instructions. For example, some medications should be taken on an empty stomach, while some should be taken with food.

CONSISTENCY – Take your medication regularly and consistently. If you miss a dose, contact your pharmacist immediately for further instructions.
