

Finding the best parking space for your intended destination

Look below to find the service you'll be coming for.

Choose the North Visitor lot if you're coming for:

- Rehabilitation Services (Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech Therapy, Massage Therapy)
- Lab work
- Most Diagnostic Imaging Services (Radiology, CT, Ultrasound, Nuclear Medicine)
- Registration for outpatient services/admitting
- Heart or vascular treatment at the W. Warren Shelden Heart and Circulatory Center
- Mammograms*
- Cancer treatment*
- Cafeteria

Special note for cancer patients or those coming for mammograms:

After parking in the north lot, proceed to the Van Elslander Cancer Center instead of the main entrance of the hospital (Van Elslander Pavilion). The Cancer Center is located to the east of the North Visitor Lot.

Choose the East Deck if you're coming for:

- A physician office visit in Professional Building 2 or Professional Building 1 (the third level of the East Deck has reserved patient/visitor parking and a convenient walkway)
- Spine Center at St. John
- MRI and PET/CT

Choose the West Deck if you're coming for:

- Any of the Intensive Care Units
- Birthing Center
- Emergency Center
- Pediatrics
- Local Surgery
- Pediatric Ambulatory Surgery
- Endoscopy
- General patient units

CareLink \$2 Valet

If you are "55 or better" and a CareLink member, simply show your CareLink Membership Card to the valet attendant to receive a 50 percent discount on valet services (regularly \$4).

Valet Parking Locations and Hours of Service

- Main Entrance at Van Elslander Pavilion: Monday to Friday, 5 a.m. - 7:30 p.m. Vehicles are returned until 9 p.m.
- South Entrance (I-94 side of SJH&MC): Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. - 7:30 p.m. and Saturday to Sunday, 9 a.m. - 7:30 p.m. Vehicles are returned until 9 p.m.
- East Entrance at Professional Building One: Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Vehicles are returned until 5:30 p.m.
- Van Elslander Cancer Center: Monday to Friday, 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Vehicles are returned until 5 p.m.
- Valet is closed on holidays.

Free Self-Parking

- North Visitor's Parking Lot
- East Parking Deck
- West Parking Deck

Handicapped parking is located conveniently at the front of the North Visitor's Parking Lot and on each level of the East and West Parking Decks near the elevators.

Multiple Day Parking Passes

- Extended parking passes are available for valet parking. The following passes may be purchased at the Cashier's Office.
- Short Term Parking Pass (7 consecutive days) — \$15
 - Long Term Parking Pass (30 consecutive days) — \$30

Easily find your way to our campus

Pick your closest freeway and follow the simple directions to get to St. John Hospital and Medical Center.

I-94

If you're coming from the west, take I-94 east to Moross (Exit 224A). Turn right on to Moross. We're $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile down on the left.

I-696

Take I-696 east to I-94 west. Stay on I-94 to Moross (Exit 224A). Turn left on to Moross. We're $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile down on the left.

I-75

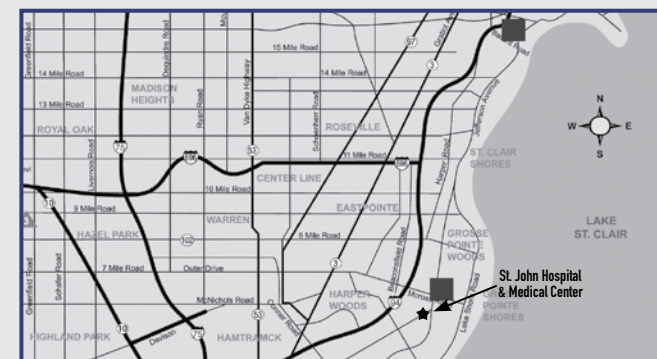
If you're coming from the north, take I-75 to I-696 east. Exit to I-94 west. Stay on I-94 to Moross (Exit 224A). Turn left on to Moross. We're $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile down on the left. If you're coming from Detroit, take I-75 to I-94 east. Stay on I-94 to Moross (Exit 224A). Turn right on to Moross. We're $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile down on the right.

Lodge Freeway (M-10)

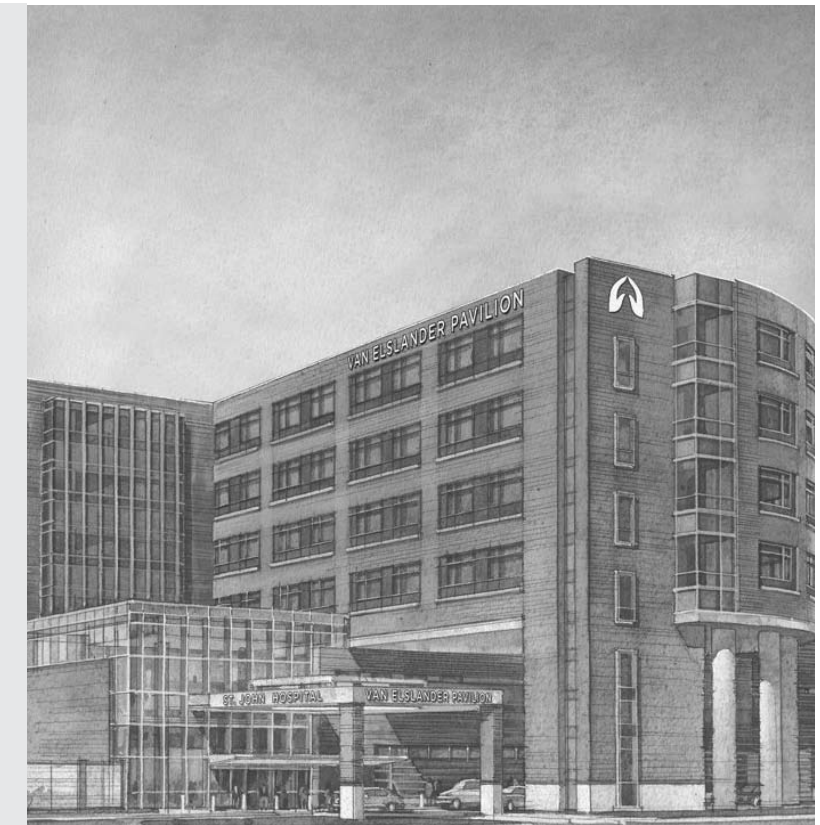
Take the Lodge to I-94 east. Stay on I-94 to Moross (Exit 224A). Turn right on to Moross. We're $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile down on the left.

Jeffries Freeway (I-96)

Take the Jeffries to I-94 east. Stay on I-94 to Moross (Exit 224A). Turn right on to Moross. We're $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile down on the left.

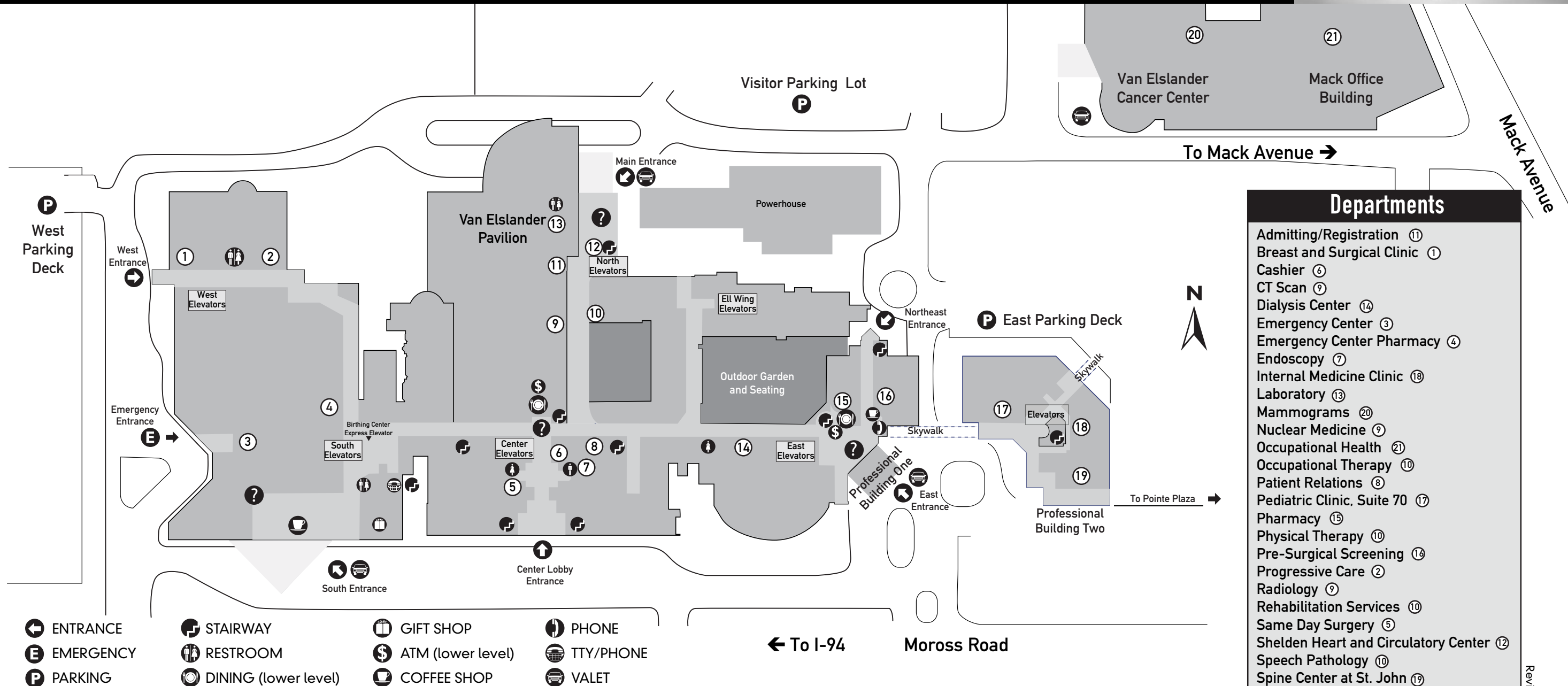
