Sliding Scale Fees for most Health Centers except St. Vincent DePaul

Primary care services usually include the regular services you would receive from your family doctor. They might include preventive care, health education, treatment of long term (chronic) diseases like high blood pressure or diabetes. St John Health is either directly providing primary care or partners with others in the community to provide health care to all those in need. This care is provided regardless of ability to pay. Some sites charge a set fee or use a sliding scale to determine fees. Yet, no one is turned away if they are in need.

The primary care sites listed in the brochure provide primary medical care to uninsured adults and one site provides pediatric care. All sites use a different model for providing care. Services may vary dependent upon the site. These sites do not provide emergency care although patients may walk-in to certain sites and if time permits they may be seen.
