Our History

St. John Macomb Hospital has a strong tradition of meeting the health care needs our community. In fact, the hospital got its start in the mid-1950s when Warren community leaders began to feel the need for expanded health care services. These concerned citizens formed the South Macomb Hospital Corporation. They sought advice from Detroit Memorial Hospital, and from this working relationship Detroit-Macomb Hospital Corporation was born in 1961.

Financing for the hospital included loans from the City of Warren (which purchased the land for the hospital) and pledges from the medical staff. Most importantly, hundreds of people throughout Macomb County contributed to a fund drive to open the new facility.

Ground was broken in 1964, and in 1966 South Macomb Hospital opened its doors at its present location at East Twelve Mile and Hoover roads in Warren. The hospital opened with 202 beds and 40 bassinets. A building expansion in the mid-1970s enlarged the hospital and added more beds.

In 1987 South Macomb Hospital was renamed Macomb Hospital Center to emphasize its broad geographic outreach and its wide range of services. The hospital became a member of St. John Health System in 1997 and its name was changed to St. John Macomb Hospital in 1998.

Our Centers of Excellence

Though the years St. John Macomb Hospital has continued to expand services and reach out to our community to meet its varied health care needs. Recent additions include a new spacious, patient-friendly Surgery Center to serve both inpatients and outpatients, the addition of MRI (Magnetic Resonance Imaging) services within the hospital and a state-of-the-art linear accelerator for cancer treatment.

Behavioral Medicine

Our comprehensive Behavioral Medicine Services include: 24-hour emergency assessment, adult inpatient program, inpatient and outpatient electroconvulsive therapy (ECT), neuropsychiatric program, outpatient program, psychological services and community and professional education. Occupational therapy and therapeutic recreation are also represented.

Cancer Care

St. John Macomb Hospital offers the expertise of a professional, dedicated staff supported by advanced technology to provide outstanding care for cancer patients. Our skilled staff of doctors, nurses and technicians excel at cancer diagnosis and treatment and caring for our patients' needs. Our program was the first in Macomb County approved by the American College of Surgeons' Commission on Cancer. This approval recognizes the oncology program for excellence in diagnostic methods, surgical capabilities, therapy, nursing, involvement of staff and administration, cancer education and the cancer registry. In addition to standard treatments, our Radiation Therapy department offers 3-D treatment planning, intraoperative radiation therapy and Brachytherapy — or prostate seed implantations. Plans are under way to greatly expand the center.

Cardiology Services

Our Cardiology Services, a division of the St. John Cardiovascular Institute, include: 24 hour emergency assessment, 83 monitored Cardiac Care beds, diagnostic Cardiac Catheterization Laboratory, Echocardiography, Stress Testing including Nuclear, Pharmacological and Stress Echocardiography, and a Pacemaker Clinic.

Emergency Center



The Emergency Center at St. John Macomb Hospital provides a spacious, state-of-the-art unit for patients who need urgent care for sudden illness, accidents and severe or life-threatening conditions. We treat approximately 38,000 patients each year. Macomb Express also is offered, which provides treatment services for patients with less serious medical conditions that are not life-threatening or do not require complex treatment.

Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Services

St. John Macomb Hospital's Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation Services Department is one of the state's largest programs and carries CARF (Commission for Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) accreditation. The components that make up the program include:

■ **Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit** - Our skilled staff provide interdisciplinary care that includes Rehabilitation Physicians, Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Speech-Language Pathology, Audiology, Therapeutic Recreation, Medical Social Work and Rehabilitation Nursing. These services benefit a wide range of patients with illness or injury that has resulted in trauma, post surgical procedures, deconditioning, degenerative conditions, neurological conditions and other life changing illness or injuries. Specialized services include a traumatic brain injury program, pet therapy and several support groups for patients and their caregivers.



■ **Outpatient Services** - Outpatient services are available at a variety of sites to enable patients to continue their progress toward recovery while enjoying the benefits of independent living. Services benefit those with orthopedic injuries, hand injuries, sports injuries, head and neck pain, neurological disorders, stroke, amputations and back injuries. Specialized outpatient services include Audiology (including hearing aid screening and fitting), Aquatic Therapy and Massage Therapy. Outpatient services are conveniently located in Clinton Township, Rochester Hills, Shelby Township and Warren.

Surgical Services

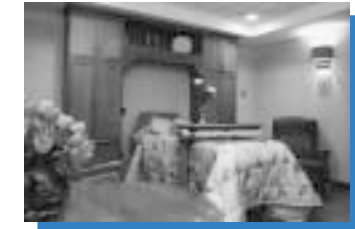
St. John Macomb Hospital opened a new Surgery Center in Fall 1999. It features eight state-of-the-art operating rooms (with another shelled for future use), a family waiting area, two consultation rooms for surgeons to use when talking with families, preoperative holding and two recovery areas. The new Surgery Center is used for both inpatient and outpatient surgery.



Our Orthopaedic Sports Medicine Program specializes in the surgical repair of knees, ankles, shoulders and elbows, through the expertise of renowned orthopaedic surgeons. In addition, our Surgery Department excels in General Surgery, Vascular, Gynecology, Urology, Ophthalmology and Hand Surgery.

Women's Health Services

Our women's health services span a spectrum of services that encompass pregnancy and childbirth, gynecological care, diagnostic tests, preventive medicine and medical/surgical treatment.



The Family Birthplace, our Labor/Delivery/Recovery/Postpartum (LDRP) unit, features a progressive, family-centered approach to the birthing experience. All phases of childbirth are completed in one home-like room, which has such amenities as a recliner, rocker, kitchenette and whirlpool bath. Patients receive comprehensive education and support throughout their pregnancy and following the baby's birth through our Perinatal Primary Nursing Program, which pairs a nursing team with the patient. Our New Family Health Education program provides education and information. A Lactation Consultant is available for support 24 hours a day. All infants born at St. John Macomb Hospital undergo infant hearing screening prior to discharge.

Mammography is available at the St. John Macomb Breast Center located at 28363 Hoover Road, Warren. The center has two advanced mammography units that use a very low level of radiation to image breast tissue. Also offered are ultrasound-guided biopsy, Stereotactic biopsy and bone densitometry services. The center is accredited by the American College of Radiology.

Additional Services

St. John Macomb Hospital is also known for many other comprehensive services, including its outstanding Medical-Surgical Care, Radiology services and Intensive Care services, with a new ICU/CCU opening in 2001.
