Evaluation and treatment are most often provided to patients with any of the following conditions:

- Prematurity

- Developmental Delays/Disorders
- Orthopedic and Neurological Disorders
- Amputations
- Hearing Loss
- Speech and Language and Voice Disorders
- Cerebral Palsy and Congenital Defects
- Spina Bifida
- Juvenile Arthritis
- Cleft Lip/Palate and Swallowing Disorders
- Feeding Dysfunctions
- Autism/Pervasive Developmental Disorders
- Traumatic Brain Injuries
- Swallowing Disorders
- Down Syndrome
