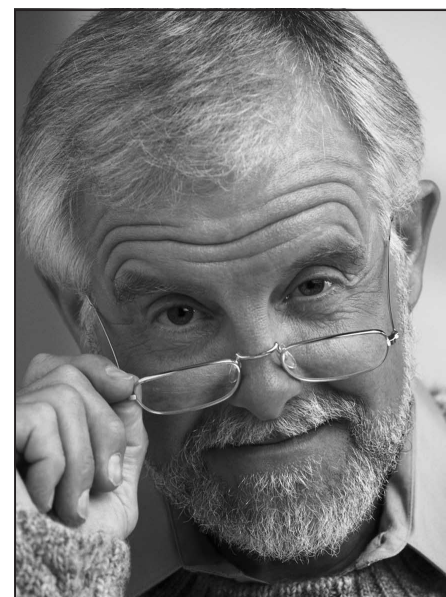
What volunteers do:
